'Design Development- Bodywork to Fashion Illustrations'

FROM THE ASSESMENT BRIEF:

SKETCHBOOK RESEARCH AND DESIGN DEVELOPMENT:

YOU ARE REQUIRED TO EMPHASIZE YOUR OWN PRIMARY RESEARCH IN THE EARLY DEVELOPMENT OF YOUR IDEAS. A LARGE VOLUME OF RICH AND VARIED ORIGINAL ARTWORK IS VITAL TO COMMUNICATE YOUR INDIVIDUAL TEXTILE DIRECTION. YOUR SKETCHBOOK SHOULD INCLUDE EXPLORATIVE AND EXPRESSIVE RESEARCH AND DESIGN DEVELOPMENT FROM CONCEPT INSPIRATION, WITH A FOCUS ON DRAWING, UNIQUE PRIMARY RESEARCH AND EXPLORING TREND AND DESIGN PRINCIPLES. YOUR TEXTILE DEVELOPMENT SHOULD INCLUDE CRAFT EXPERIMENTATION, FABRIC SAMPLES, EXPLORATION OF SCALE AND PLACEMENT ON THE BODY TO DEVELOP A RANGE OF TEXTILES FOR FASHION.

TECHNICAL FILE:

IN ADDITION TO THE FINAL SAMPLES, IT IS VITAL TO DOCUMENT YOUR TECHNICAL AND CRAFT PROCESSES THROUGHOUT THE PROJECT AND TO SUBMIT A TECHNICAL FILE. THIS IS A MINIMUM A4 FILE CONTAINING DIGITAL AND CRAFT PROCESSES RELATING TO YOUR SPECIALISM. THIS CAN INCLUDE PHOTOGRAPHS, NOTES AND ANNOTATED SPEC SHEETS WHERE APPLICABLE. YOUR TECHNICAL FILE SHOULD SHOWCASE ALL SKILLS LEARNT IN CLASS AS WELL AS INDEPENDENT EXPERIMENTATION. YOU NEED TO SHOW A LARGE AMOUNT OF TECHNIQUE EXPLORATION, SAMPLE POSSIBILITIES, TECHNICAL TESTING AND PROBLEM SOLVING THROUGH TO REFINEMENT.
